1. Marques de Calado Macabeo, Spain, 13% <i>Fresh floral aromas with refreshing citrus characteristics.</i>	£14.95
2. Five Foot Track Chardonnay, Australia, 12.5% <i>This Chardonnay is packed with tropical fruit flavours and a soft mouth feel.</i>	£15.95
3. Aires Andinos Sauvignon Blanc, Argentina, 13% <i>A zesty, clean and aromatic Argentinian Sauvignon Blanc that is fruity yet clean, crisp and refreshing.</i>	£16.95
4. Pinot Grigio Malandrino, Italy, 12% <i>Made using 100% Pinot Grigio this wine displays notes of citrus fruits, with a hint of floral aromas.</i>	£17.95
5. Fernlands Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand, 13% <i>Displaying ripe gooseberries followed by crisp, clean acidity and a refreshing finish that are the hallmark of this unmistakable Marlborough Sauvignon.</i>	£19.95

10. Five Foot Track Shiraz, Australia, 13% <i>A pleasing balance between ripe fruit and savoury notes on the nose. The palate is succulent and mouth filling with red berry and brambles.</i>	£16.95
11. Pavillon des Trois Arches Merlot, France, 13% <i>A very charming nose of red berries and sweet spice. The palate is smooth, full of dark creamy fruit with a lingering finish.</i>	£17.95
12. San Millan Reserva Rioja, Spain, 13% <i>An extremely fresh nose with aromas of ripe red fruits and a subtle floral bouquet and notes of cinnamon and cloves. On the palate the wine is soft yet with good body and a remarkable structure.</i>	£21.95
13. Châteauneuf-du-Pape 'Cuvée des Antiques', France, 14% <i>Aged in the famous cellars of Ogier Caves des Papes in the heart of Châteauneuf-du-Pape, this wine is dark ruby with a complex nose of spices and hints of pear with a smooth and lingering finish.</i>	£22.95
